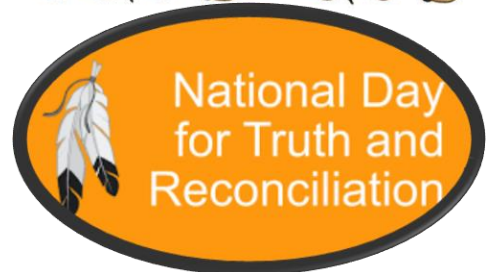


### Thanksgiving

The Village Office and Landfill will be closed on Thursday, September 30, in honour of the National Day of Truth and Reconciliation.

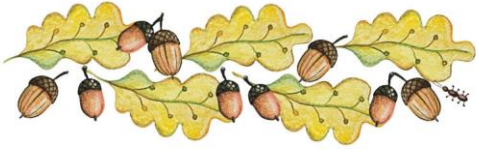


### Autumn Equinox
